Contest Guidelines

- Limit 1 entry per person.
- All entries must be accompanied by an entry form. Each participant must submit an online entry form and upload an image of the entry.
- All entries must be the entrant's original work. If any element of an entrant's entry infringes upon the rights of another person, the entry will be disqualified from the contest.
- All artwork is to be designed by service learning students. Students in grades K-11 may create a word theme and draw a picture (logo) to accompany the words.
- The theme should represent what service learning means to its participants. Artwork must include "STEM Library Lab" and "Service Learning".
- The artwork must have a border (can be part of a design or in color) with at least a half inch margin outside of the border.
- The artwork must be on an unlined 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper. Collages, computer-generated artwork, photography, or photocopies will not be accepted. *Please use art materials with vibrant, intense colors that produce a saturated composition. Pencil and light crayons do not reproduce well. The artwork will be photocopied and scanned.*
- Check all grammar and spelling on your entry. Do not wrap text or split lines with hyphens.
- By entering the contest, participants grant permission for their artwork, name, and photo to be featured on the STEM Library Lab website, social media, and printed materials for promotional purposes.
