

Recipients of Ready-to-Go project funding are **required** to attend an orientation before beginning the project. Orientation dates and registration information are available here.









REFLECTION REQUIREMENT

A new requirement has been instituted for the 2023-2024 school year. Reflection samples are required as part of your expenditure, reflection, and evaluation report. Excerpts or quotes from students are not acceptable samples.

Reflection should generally occur after the investigation, planning, and action stages of your project.



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Grant Opportunity: The Youth as Solutions program is an opportunity for students in grades 6-12 to make a difference in the community with the support of NYLC. Teams receive a \$250-\$1,000 grant for project expenses and national recognition via the NYLC website and social media. Adults receive free high-quality professional development and coaching.
