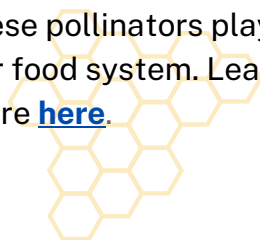


PROJECT CHANGES
