#### **UPCOMING CHANGES**

Two major changes are on the horizon for the 2025-2026 application season:

- 1. An individual teacher may apply for up to <u>two</u> Ready-to-Go projects. Administrators are encouraged to have interested teachers apply, rather than assign projects to teachers.
- 2. Applications must be submitted before or on April 4, 2025, if you wish to receive feedback or opportunities to make revisions.

#### **EMMY NOETHER SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Emmy Noether Award is a merit-based award presented annually to (3) female high school seniors aspiring to pursue post-graduate degrees in STEM-related fields. After completing undergraduate studies, the Gold Medalist will receive up to \$75,000, and the two Silver Medalists will be awarded \$25,000 each for qualified graduate-level programs (to be divided over a 3-year span).
